Action Needed:

Old Business:

Multi-Unit Housing: One multi-unit housing property with a smoke-free policy. Currently working with Myra Mellencamp.

New Business:

Got approval from State Health Department to do more than descriptive data on the tenant survey which may be more useful in helping housing authorities modify or implement policy.

Quitline: Increase provider referrals by 20%

Old Business:

Continued presentation to medical providers. Have enrolled 67 preferred providers (as of 1-12-20). Jackson County is in the top 10 in the state of "patients reached." Shows referrals based on 'quit-ready,' not just referral numbers.

New Business: Request for signage.

Action Needed: Small taskforce to decide on criteria, publication, and distribution of signage.

- Sub-committee on signage (investigate cost and distribution): Bethany, Lynn

Coalition: Increase# of coalition members by 5 each quarter

Old Business:

New Business:
